



Pierrefonds Soccer Association Referee Training Program 2008

Pierrefonds Soccer is now accepting applications for new referees for the 2008 season.

Description

The House-League training program is a 24-30 hour program of instruction for those wishing to become referees. Those successfully completing the course will be able to referee in youth recreational games and be an assistant referee in youth competitive games.

Duration

The course has been designed with about 18-24 hours of in-classroom instruction followed by six hours of on-field instruction. The classroom instruction will be held in 3-6 hour sessions to allow time for reading the material being provided and also to enhance the learning process.

Dates

The dates for the course will be advised within the next several weeks. The aim is to hold the training on Saturday or Sunday mornings, depending on the availability of the training facility and instructors.

Requirements

Participants must be 14 years old AS OF JANUARY 1, 2008 to attend this Entry Level course. There is no maximum age limit. Referees must be registered with the Pierrefonds Soccer Association to officiate games, and to be covered by the Insurance Program.

Fee

There is no fee for this entry level course.

Attendance

Attendance at all sessions is mandatory. Special circumstances will be considered only on request. Refereeing soccer can be a rewarding experience; however, if one is not adequately prepared, the experience can be an unpleasant one.
